Sheffield Park

Leave the hustle and bustle of everyday life behind. Take your time exploring our enchanting countryside.



Take a wander through ancient Sussex Woodlands. **Abbot's Wood** was once part of the great Saxon forest of Andredesweald, which stretched across the whole of the south-east of England as far west as Hampshire. Or bring stories to life at Ashdown Forest, the former ancient Royal Hunting Forest, and the setting for AA Milne's

Winnie The Pooh. Here you will find over 80 miles of footpaths to explore.

The Cuckoo Trail and the Forest Way Country Park are both former railway lines and traffic free, providing ideal paths for walking, cycling and horse riding.

Birling Gap is part of the world famous **Seven Sisters** cliffs, one of the longest stretches of undeveloped coastline on


the south coast. Take your time reflecting on the gleaming chalk and unspoilt views of dramatic coastline.

The High Weald is the fourth largest Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty in England and Wales. As well as enjoying the beautiful countryside and landscapes, there are opportunities for walking,

cycling, visiting attractions and rock climbing. Look out for rarer species of birds such as the fieldfare and the nightjar and shy wildlife such as deer and dormice.

In the **High Weald** the frequent passage of pigs being driven to and from their dens formed tracks known as droves and over time the dens became settlements in their own right!

Discover *our places*

Nestled amongst Wealden's idyllic countryside are untold hidden gems; vibrant market towns and unspoilt villages with their iconic architecture give visitors the chance to soak up the real Sussex.

Romans, Saxons and Normans have all made Wealden their home. Our enchanting castles, churches, priories and historic houses tell the story of two thousand years of diverse and evocative history.

Wealden is alive with exotic zoos, working steam railways, colourful gardens and activity-filled reservoirs. Explore the observatory and science centre; fun and learning for young and old. And when it's time to refuel there's an abundance of cosy pubs and quaint tearooms around every corner.



Wherever you are staying in Wealden, there are a multitude of places just waiting to be found.

Crowborough, in the north, is one of the highest points in Sussex. Within easy reach are the impressive ruins of *Bayham Abbey*. Or visit the oldest, only working open-trestle post mill in the country, *Nutley Windmill*. For the adrenaline junkies among you, why not experience the incredible *Aqua Park* or sailing at *Bewl Water*? For a different thrill, try your outdoor climbing skills at *Nuts 4 Climbing* and *Bowles Outdoor Centre*.



Central Wealden opens up many more possibilities. *Heathfield* is an attractive market town standing on a ridgeway surrounded by beautiful rolling Sussex countryside. Time travel on one of our steam railways across the Weald. Discover Hertsmonceux, one of the oldest significant brick buildings still

standing in England. Experience spectacular hands-on science among the domes and telescopes of a world famous astronomical observatory.



South Wealden boasts the *Pevensey* area, which is famous for its bay, castle and links with Anglo-Saxon history. Explore the medieval thatched *Alfriston Clergy House*, situated in one of the prettiest villages of East Sussex. Nearby



you will find the world famous *Seven Sisters Country Park* and *The Long Man of Wilmington*, the mysterious guardian of the South Downs.

Did you know?

The *Bluebell Railway, Sheffield Park*, was used in the film 'Room with a View' from E. M. Forster's book. It was also used for scenes from the 'Railway Children' and 'Khartoum' with Charlton Heston. And 'Goodbye Christopher Robin', the film based on the relationship between writer AA Milne and his son was filmed in *Ashdown Forest*, which was also their home.

Cuckoo Trail

This 14 mile surfaced path runs through the heart of the Sussex countryside. It is mostly traffic free and is a safe route for walkers, horse riders and cyclists of all ages, forming part of the **National Cycle Network**. The picturesque trail follows the former 'Cuckoo Line' railway track and stretches from Heathfield to Eastbourne. It passes through Horam, Hellingly, Hailsham and Polegate. **For map, please see back cover foldout.**



What you will find

The trail takes you through woodland, open grassland, and pasture, where you will find an array of wildlife. The cuckoo, the green

woodpeckers and the dunnoek sparrow are just a few possibilities and a collection of seasonal wildflowers, oak and iron sculptures and carved wooden seats can also be found along the trail. Download the seasonal spotter guide or more information, see www.healthywealden.co.uk/cuckoo-trail

Whilst immersed in the wildlife, try not to miss the Victorian engineering skills in the brick arch bridges, between Hellingly and Horam. The most striking example being Heathfield Tunnel.

Adjacent to the trail you will find **Off The Line vineyard**. The vineyard entrance is open by prior arrangement, on selected weekends from May until September www.offthelinevineyard.com. And close by is **Hidden Spring vineyard** in Horam, www.hiddenspring.co.uk
